A NOTAM will be issued that will stop the Tower Control Service from Friday at 18.00 local time until Sunday at 15:30 local time.

Aircraft that cannot operate usually at our controlled airport will be able to enter it during this period. From the Control Tower and in its usual frequency 121,325 megahertz, controllers will be facilitated information and help.





06 Highlights



The LleidaAirChallenge fair is the only fair of this area in Catalonia and Spain. It has become a business platform and innovation because the exhibitors, public and aviation lovers create business synergies expanding knowledge, experience and information.





This year is the ninth fair if we count the fair that was held in October 2013. It has changed the date of the fair and this year it was held in in October, Saturday 7th and Sunday 8th. The LleidaAirChallenge Fair has closed its doors with an influx of 5,500 visitors, that have been able to visit close to a hundred of installed exhibitors and attend and take part in the wide range of activities organized around it of the world of aeronautics. The number of visitors this year exceeds by 30% that of the previous edition.





120 aircraft have visited the airport. The airport has fly-in throughout the fair and has air controllers that will facilitate information and help to those who want to come flying. This year, the fair has a new location, at industrial platform. This platform that is starting to take shape, they will occupy it three tents with exhibitors along with one fifteen aircraft on display and a space for bar and food trucks.



About 90 national and international companies related to general and commercial aviation have exhibited their products, services and/or projects. A part of this has also been enabled by the platform to display various aircraft: helicopters, ULMs, biplanes, turboprops, drones... The exhibitors this year have been distributed in three spaces: one, dedicated to

New Space activity and new aeronautical and space technologies; a second, in the scope of the training; the third, to companies in the aeronautical sector. The fair has for the first time included the on-site purchase and sale of second-hand aircraft, specifically of three small planes and a helicopter.

08 History

2013

The first idea of organizing a festival related to the aeronautical world was in 2013 when we believed the airport was a useful showcase for the companies and enterprises in Catalonia. We organized an event with parades of ultra-light aircraft, general aviation and historical aircraft, demonstrations of rescues, sailboats, balloons and aeromodeling



2015

The Lleida Air Challenge festival repeated its success consolidating air shows and improving the experience for the public at the Lleida-Alguaire airport. There were also some stands of companies based in the airport, flight schools, aeronautical shops, etc.



2014

The second year it became a bigger event and we included the English/American Air RaceF1 announcing the first international Formula 1 Class air racing competition on the 1st June. This was a showcase of the world's premier Formula 1 air racing pilots and their highperformance race planes.



2016

This year the number of aircraft of the different aerial modalities that took part in the Lleida Air Challenge was over 40. In addition, the festival had a covered space to host exhibitors from the aeronautical sector at a trade fair organized by Fira de Lleida.



2017

Last year there was an improvement in the air festival itself with new acrobatic exhibitions to attract the general public and especially the family, with the static exhibition of airplanes. We have also been professionalizing the trade fair set at the airport to get a professional aeronautical aviation fair.



2019

An aeronautical fair with more than 80 stands, set in the airport facilities for the first time and including parades of ultra-light aircraft, general aviation aircraft and acrobatics.



2018

An aeronautical fair with more than 60 stands, set in the airport facilities for the first time and including parades of ultra-light aircraft, general aviation aircraft and acrobatics.



2022

After the pandemic the fair opens again with great expectations, great feedback from everybody, nearly 100 stands and all the platform with aircrafts on display.



2023

The fair attracts professionals, enthusiasts and general public who share an interest in aviation. This year it is proved that the fair is consolidated, as a platform for industry and professionals to network, explore businesses and showcase and demonstrate their capacities.




